We are Sisters

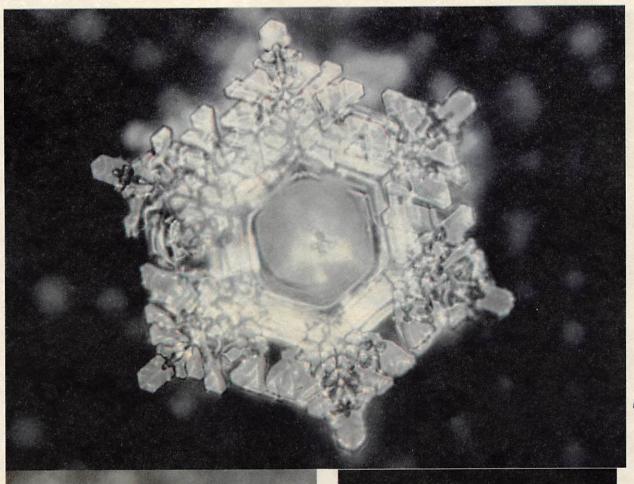

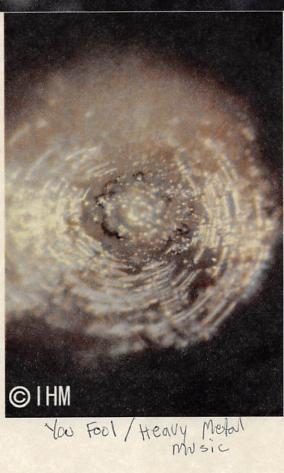
